It was first opened in November of 2016 in Lance's backyard and within a year moved into the current building located at 801 11th Street.



A new brochure has been designed including new plant material added this year with photos and information about each signed plant.



Special Agent to the San Angelo Resident Agency for the FBI's Dallas Division, Josh MacDiarmid, spoke to Chamber members, residents and county officials about the services of the FBI on Wednesday, July 24th. Special Agent MacDiarmid is responsible for covering White Collar violations, including frauds and swindles of various types, including offenses against financial institutions.

Attendees were informed that the FBI is the lead federal agency for investigating cyber attacks by criminals, overseas adversaries, and terrorists. "The threat is incredibly serious and growing", said MacDiarmid. "Cyber intrusions are becoming more commonplace, more dangerous, and more sophisticated. Our nation's critical infrastructure, including both private and public sector networks, are targeted by adversaries. American companies are targeted for trade secrets and other sensitive corporate data, and universities for their cutting-edge research and development. Citizens are targeted by fraudsters and identity thieves, and children are targeted by online predators."

Attendees were informed of the following:

-A new program called InfraGard was discussed. This program involves the FBI aligning with private and public sector companies and organizations to protect our nations infrastructure from both physical and cyber attacks.

-Internet Complaint Crime Center (IC3) where you can report Internet online crime complaints at <u>www.IC3.gov.</u> Here the FBI will accept complaints from either the actual victim or from a third party to the complaint.

-A common threat is Ransomware where someone holds the key to your computer and demands money to return control of your PC. The best response is to simply get another PC. Always keep your PC updated to try and avoid identity theft of your personal information.

-To be wary of point-of-sale devices such as ATM's and gas stations when using your credit card.

-If you are unsure of a received e-mail, delete it before clicking on or opening any attachments. There are a ton of scams where your computer is compromised due to responding to unknown e-mails.

-Commodities Fraud-Where you are tricked into investing in a stock that is then intentionally tanked. This usually involves large companies, but be prudent about anything you invest in.

-When traveling it is recommended to install "thumb print lock" or some type of app that auto locks your phone in case you lose or misplace it. This is especially true for people that keep passwords or do on-line banking on their phones that can be easily hacked.

-Get your kids off Snap Chat. Photos on Snap Chat give off meta data that can assist a hacker in tracing information about you and your location.

-Talk to your kids about the proper use of Social Media. It is not safe to constantly post your location giving hackers or criminals information about you and your family and your whereabouts.

-Continually check social media privacy settings. Keep your phone updated especially if you are using Bluetooth, which provides is a direct link to your information.
