Rusty Garvin's, aka "Rooster's"
Hot German
Potato Salad

8-10 Medium Red Potatoes / cut up into cubes / leave skin on;

1 lb. of your favorite thick sliced bacon / cut bacon into ½ inch pieces;

1 small red onion / diced;

1-2 bunches of green onions / diced;

½ cup vinegar;

½ cup sugar;

2 T. yellow mustard;

1 small jar sweet pickle relish.

Boil potatoes until soft / leave skin on / pour off water and put back in boiling pot / salt & pepper to taste. While potatoes are boiling / cook bacon until crisp / take up bacon and retain 2 T of bacon grease. On low-medium heat add onions to bacon grease and sauté until just turning soft. Add vinegar, sugar, mustard, sweet relish, and bacon to onions and simmer. Pour hot mixture over potatoes and stir in. Can serve hot, warm, room temperature, or cold.

Light should be used only when it is useful.


Use warmer color lights where possible.
