

Ways to Preserve the Night Skies and Minimize Glare at Your Home or Business:

- 1. Direct lights downward
- 2. Shield lights when possible
- 3. Use warmer light colors
- 4. Lights should be no brighter than necessary and turned off when not in use
- 5. Avoid unnecessary glare as it can do more harm than good when lighting an area
