The Chamber of Commerce recognizes Stokes Drilling as our Business of the Month

"Our grandad, J.E. Stokes, started the business back in 1905," said Tom Stokes. "He left home at 16 years old and began drilling water wells. By age 20, he and a partner owned their own rig and the company named Stokes & Price Drilling. They drilled many shallow water wells for shot holes and recorded shock waves for oil exploration across east and west Texas.



"My dad, W.T. Stokes, went to work for Grandad in the 30's and moved back to Ozona in 1942. By the 40's, they were drilling shot holes and spent many years drilling surface wells for oil companies throughout the 60's. My dad never was drafted to war because they were assisting the government in seeking oil needed for the country at that time. In 1960, dad took over the business and the name became Stokes Drilling Company. He went back to drilling water wells."

W.T. passed away in 1983. In 1984, Tom and his oldest son Ken bought the company from Madeline Stokes and expanded its services from mostly drilling water wells to servicing submersible pumps, pressure pumps and systems, solar systems, windmills, poly pipelines, tanks and well supplies.

Today, Ken Stokes and his son Sol operate the family owned business and Tom takes care of the bookkeeping.
