Student field trips

Each year the Ozona Chamber of Commerce mails 107 packets to biology, science, physical environment systems, ag, and eco systems teachers in Ozona, Sonora, Iraan, Mertzon, Big Lake, Christoval and Eldorado. The packets contain brochures and information on locations in Ozona that teachers are invited to consider for a field trip. Locations and activities such as the Crockett County Museum, historical walking tour of the town square, a Discover Ozona GPS Crossword puzzle, and the Crockett County Interpretive Trail that includes a rain harvest exhibit and geocache, and the Visitor Center.

This year, 3rd and 5th grade classes from Ozona toured both the Visitor Center and the Crockett County Interpretive Trail. Students learned about the travelers coming into the Visitor Center, where they were from and how Tourism works within the community. They were introduced to rain harvesting, and the various uses, whether medicinal, ceremonial, symbolic, used for food or fiber, of five plants located in the trail.
